

- Past President, Brookhaven Fields Civic Association






City Formation Process

- Governor's Commission Task Force- Deadline Sept. 1, 2012
 - Identifying City Administration & Staff (City Manager, Police Chief)
 - Identifying space for city offices (lease negotiation)
 - Conducting Council member orientation
 - Bid process for city- Parks, Roads, etc.
- Election Day- Nov. 6, 2012
- Run-off vote- Dec. 4, 2012
- City operations begin Dec. 17th, 2012

CITY FACTS-

- · LARGEST CITY IN DEKALB COUNTY
- Four districts each represented by one council-member (must live in district), and a mayor
- CITY POPULATION APPROX. 49,000, EACH DISTRICT 12,250
- · Estimated Revenue \$25-27 Million
- · EINITIAL FOUR CITY SERVICES:
 - · POLICE DEPARTMENT
 - · Parks & Recreation
 - · ¿· Zoning, Code Enforcement, Land Use
 - · Roads, Drainage, & Sidewalks
- Continued use of DeKalb Co.
 Sanitation, Fire & EMS, Jail, & Courts






City Ideas
